# THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Do any of the following phrases sound familiar? We have just been so busy. I am so tired. I feel like I am on the verge of a breakdown. I wish I did not wake up each morning feeling like I have no energy. Someone get the coffee going. All these things reflect a society that is too busy and too connected. Maybe we need to begin to consider a different approach.

Today, we will examine what it means to have a Sabbath rest. What would happen in your life if you set aside one day a week to rest, reflect, and spend time with our Lord? (Just by mentioning that, I gave some of you an anxiety attack.) What if I told you that God designed us for this? He did not intend for us to constantly be on the go, always trying to do more and more.

What would happen in your life if you set aside one day a week to rest, reflect, and spend time with our Lord?

God has set up all of creation to work in a six and one rhythm. Six days to work, one


to rest. He even goes so far as to develop a Sabbath plan for the land; farm the land for six years and let it rest one. Unfortunately, we have become so connected that it is difficult to find an hour to rest, much less a day. Thus, we continue to press on as depression, anxiety, and frustration reach all new levels.

Let me challenge you to consider finding a day a week for a Sabbath rest. That would be a day for rest, reflection, worship, and restoration. Maybe that day is Sunday for you. Maybe Sundays do not work, and it needs to be another day. I'm not so sure the day of the week matters, just that there is a day. Yes, it will mean you have to postpone a thing or two. However, I have a hunch we will get much more done in six days if we take the seventh to rest. Could it be that we are missing one of God's greatest gifts?
