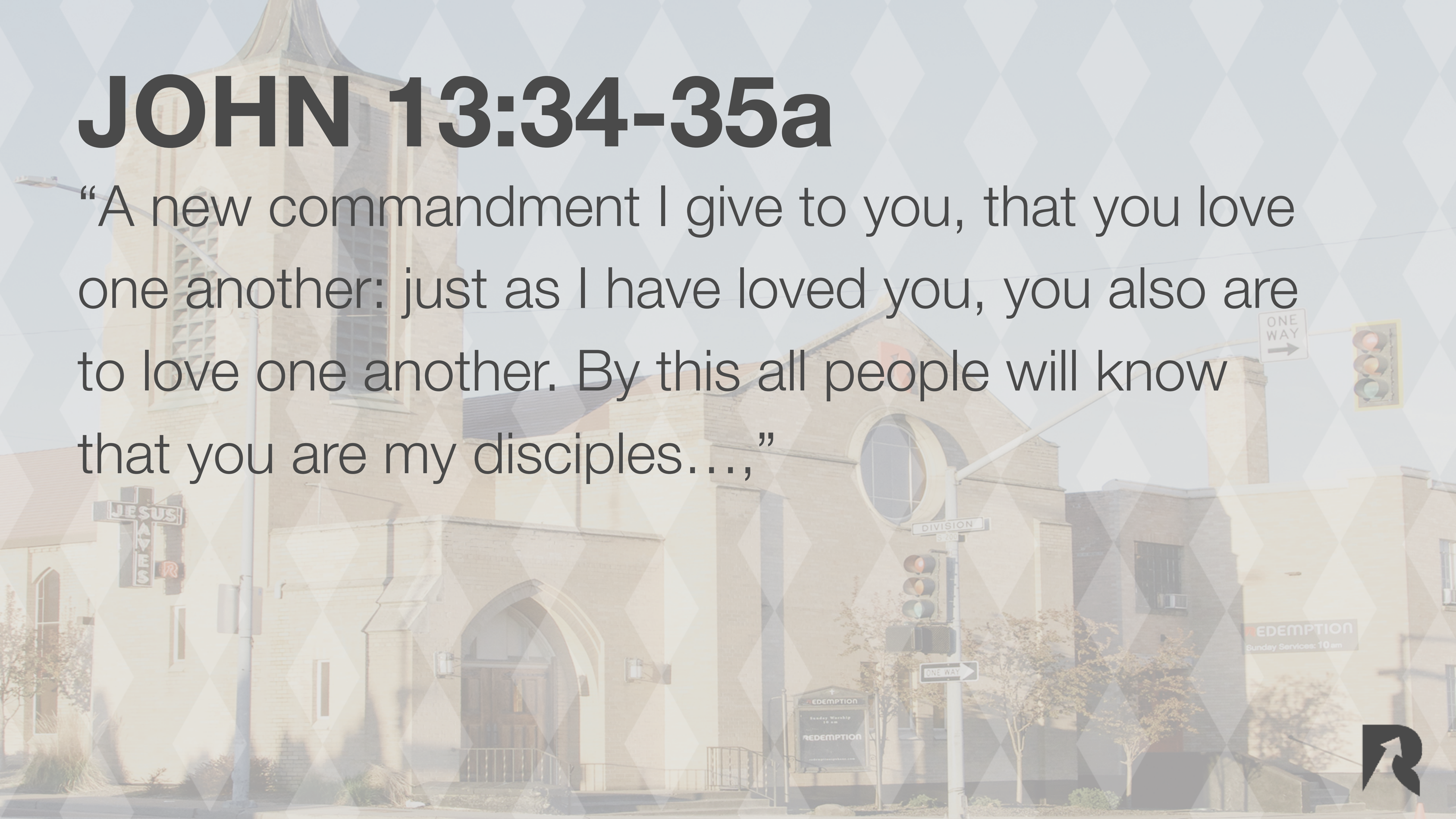


KNOWN BY OUR LOVE

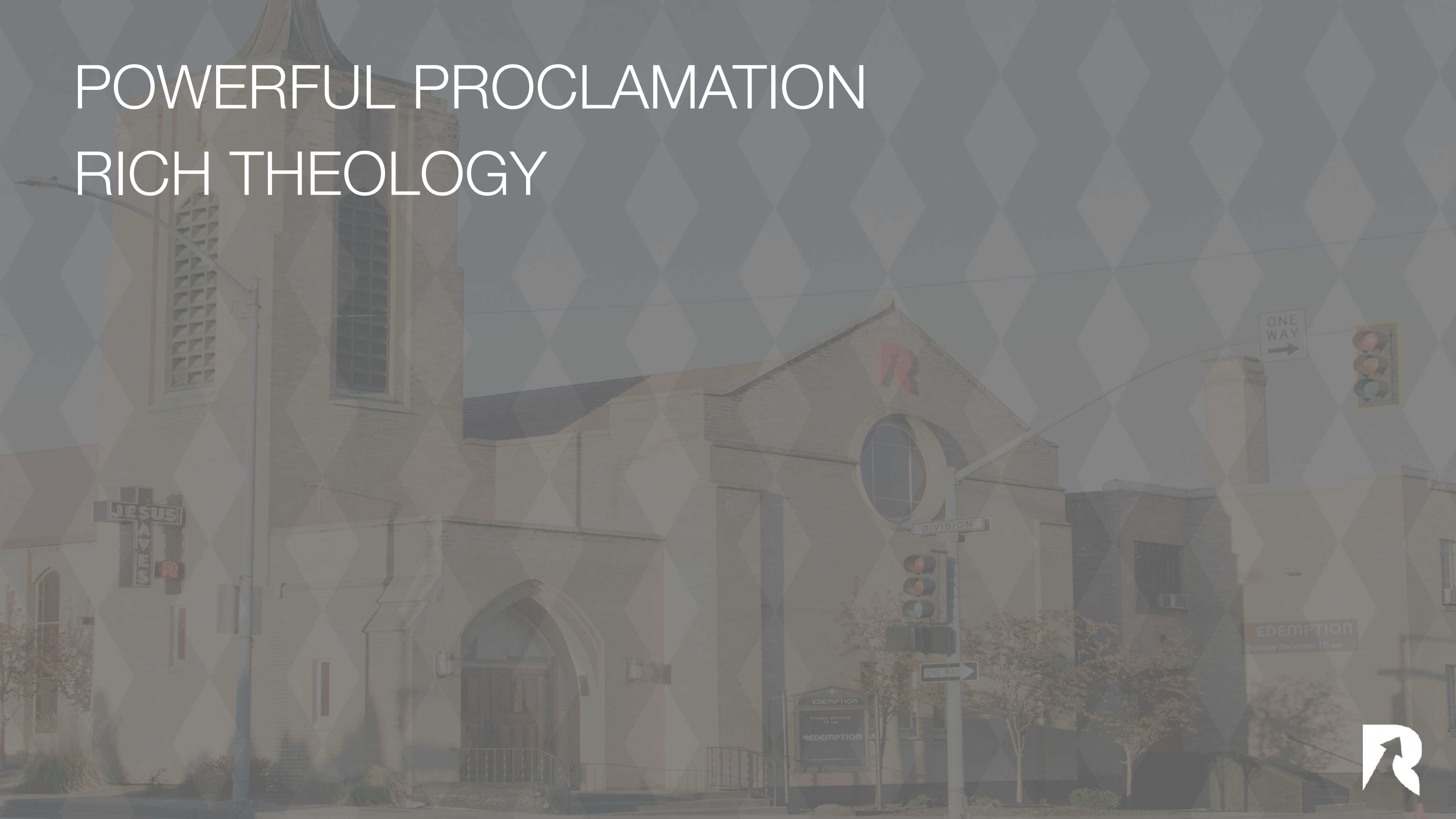

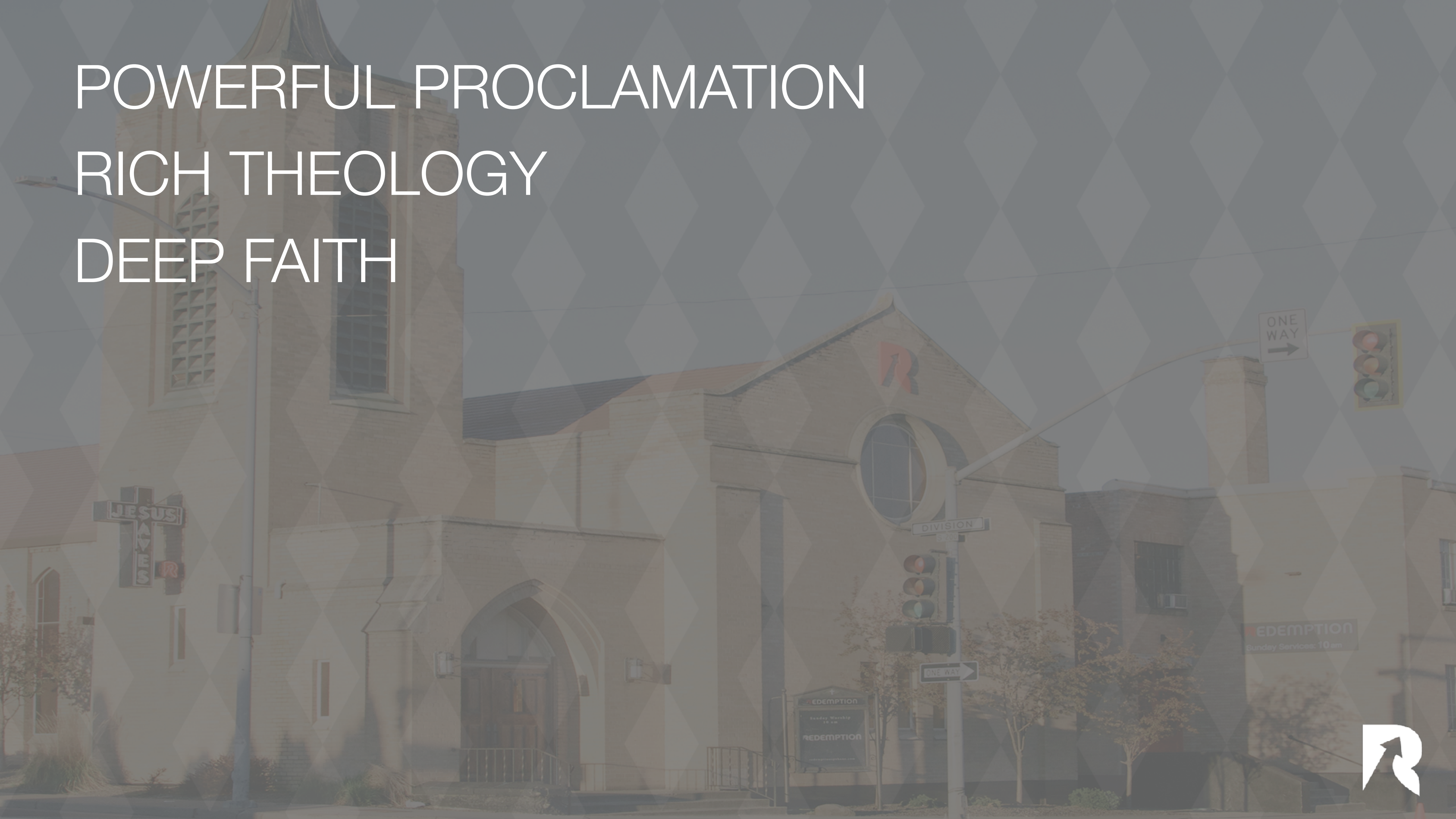

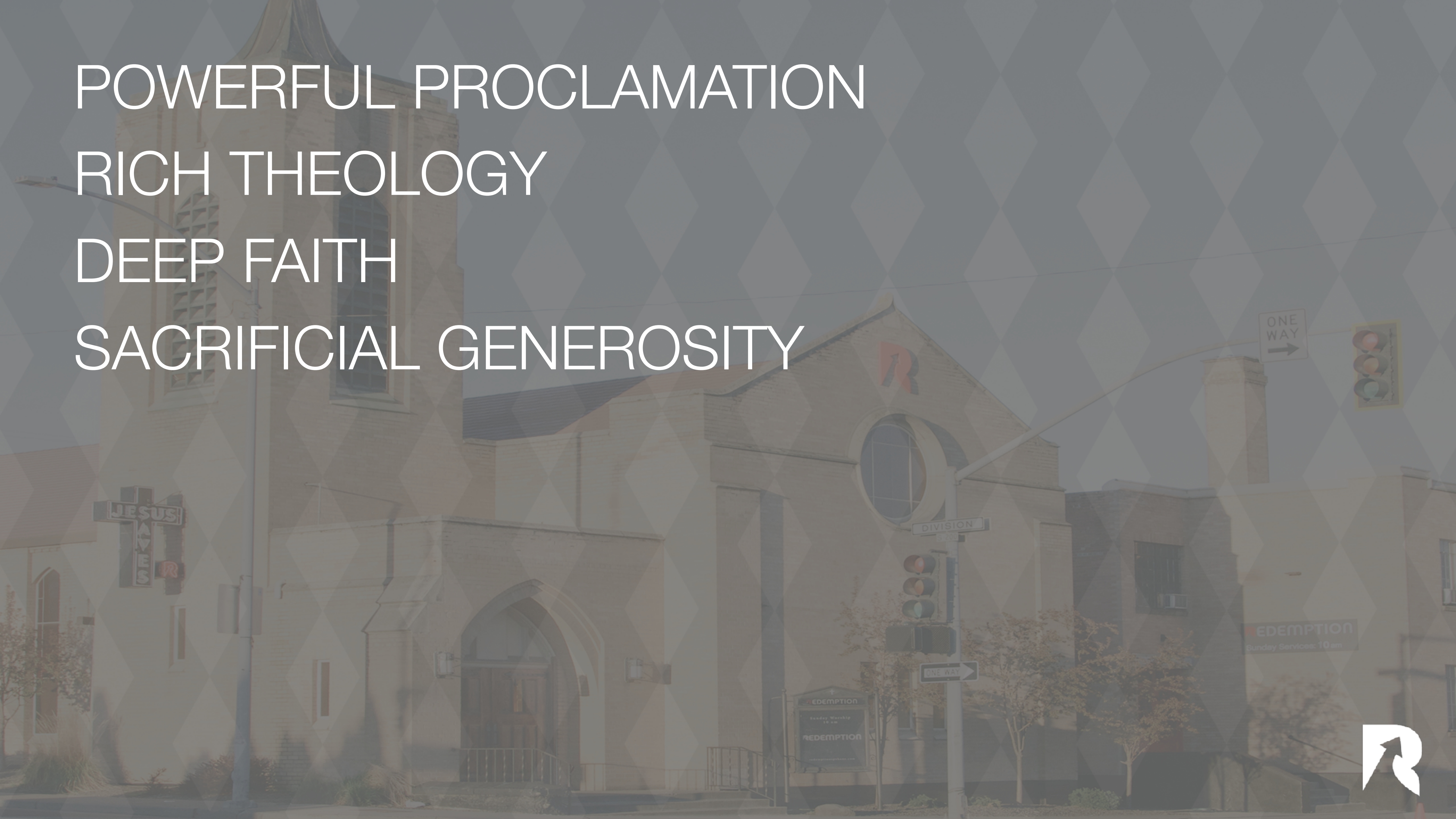
