12 STEPS TO RAISE AJJWENILE DELINQUENT

R

Begin with infancy to give the child everything he wants. In this way he will grow up to believe the world owes him a living.



STEP 2

When he picks up bad words, laugh at him. This will make him think he is cute.



STEP 3

Never give him any spiritual training. Wait until he is twenty-one and the "let him decide for himself."



Avoid using the word "wrong." He may develop a guilt complex. This will condition him to believe later, when he is arrested, that society is against him and he is the one being persecuted.



STEP 5

Pick up everything he leaves lying around. Do everything for him so that he will be experienced in throwing all of his responsibility on to others.



STEP 6

Take his side against neighbors, teachers, and policemen. They are all prejudiced against your child.



Quarrel frequently in the presence of your children. In this way they will not be shocked when your home is broken up later.



STEP 8

Give the child all the spending money he wants. Never let him earn his own.



STEP 9

Satisfy his every craving for food, drink, and comfort. See that his every desire is met and later watch him satisfy every sensual desire when he is older.



Let him read any printed material, watch any television program, and listen to any music he can get his hands on. Be careful to ensure that house is clean but let his mind feast on garbage.



When he gets into trouble, apologize to yourself by saying, "I could never get through to him."



STEP 12

Prepare for a life of grief. You will likely have it.
