“This does not mean that the promise concerning Israel has been forgotten. On the contrary. God will make Abraham’s name great (Genesis 12:2) by giving King David a great name (2 Samuel 7:9).

God will give rest to his people Israel (Deuteronomy 12:10) by giving rest to King David (2 Samuel 7:11). The Lord will do these things by providing David with offspring who will reign forever. God’s people will be his “sons” because their king will be God’s son (see Matthew 5:9; John 1:12; Romans 8:14, 19; Galatians 3:26).”
