<sup>7</sup> They shall pour forth the fame of your abundant goodness and shall sing aloud of your righteousness.

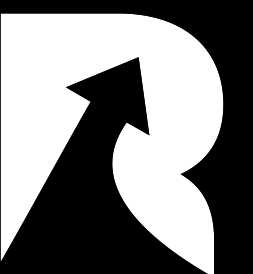
