WORD *Message Title:* "Babylon: In It, Not Of It | "What Is Babylon?" (Part 1)

Scripture: Revelation 1:3; Genesis 11:1-9, Revelation 17: 1-2;

Jeremiah 25:8-12; Jeremiah 29:4-11

1. Have a group member share a brief historical background of *Daniel*. Who was he? What was happening to the Israelites at this time in history?

- **2.** What is "Babylon"? Describe the 'Babylon' that Americans live in today.
- 3. What do we gain from studying prophecy? What might we *lose* if we don't? (Share: Is prophecy something you embrace or tend to shy away from when studying the Bible? Why or Why not?)
- **4.** Daniel was carried into exile to Babylon, yet able to maintain his faithfulness to God in the midst of its chaos (i.e, he lived *in it, not of it*). Do you find it easy or difficult to remember your identity and live faithfully as citizens of the Kingdom of Heaven, and not of the world? Why or why not?
- 5. What do you desire to learn during this study of Daniel? How do you hope to grow and mature, spiritually? Are there areas of your life you desire for the Holy Spirit to transform? Share and pray for one another about these matters.

WITNESS Read Jeremiah 29:7. Consider the the community/neighborhood God has providentially placed you in and begin to pray with intention for its welfare. Ask the Lord to use you as His witness to reach the lost around you.
