WordMessage Title: Babylon: In It, Not of It | "Sooner or Later, God Will Cut

your Down" (Part 6) by Pastor Bryan James, 11/30/2025

Scriptures: Daniel 4

1. What part of the message or Scripture stood out to you this week? Why?

- 2. Define (human) sovereignty. Compare that with the <u>absolute</u> sovereignty of God.
- 3. Read vv. 28-30. What character quality is shown in Nebuchadnezzar that God <u>hates</u>? How is this quality different than having confidence? How can you appreciate your accomplishments/gifts without pride or putting yourself down?
- 3. Read vv. 31-33. In God's love, to bring the us out of pride, he will cut us down (bring crisis) for a time, as He did with Nebuchadnezzar. What is God's ultimate purpose for cutting him/us down? What does this tell you about God's character/nature?
- **4.** Reference vv. 20-23. What "tree" of yours has been cut down and to what do you attribute that? Did you learn anything about yourself and God's authority and power through your crisis? How did it change you?
- **5.** Observe the way Daniel addresses the king in verses 19 and 27, tactfully and respectfully. How do you think the manner in which he addressed Nebuchadnezzar affected the King's final response (v. 37) to his interpretation?
- **6.** Like Daniel, how have you shown courage (and tact) in declaring God's word to others, both good and bad news? What gave you the courage and convicton to act?
- **7.** What is God impressing upon you most through this message? Does the Word bring conviction, encouragement or both?
