Welcome: What is your favorite breakfast food?

Worship: Have a member pick out a worship song or read a favorite Psalm.

## Word: Read Joshua 1:1-9

- 1. Name one part of the message that really stuck out to you.
- 2. Why was a part of God's command to Joshua to be strong and courageous?
- 3. How does knowing that God has a plan and purpose for you change the way you approach your future decisions?
- 4. Name a time that you undoubtedly experienced the presence of God in a trial.
- 5. What changes might you make in your life, trusting that God is always with you?
- 6. To move into the Promised Land, the Israelites had to take land occupied by the enemy. What land is the enemy occupying in your life? How does God call us to fight and prosper in the battle?
- 7. Why is the word of God so powerful, and how do we use His word to move out of the wilderness and into the Promised Land?

**Witness:** On a scale from 1 to 10 (10 representing a heart and life on fire for those who are lost, and a 1 representing someone who rarely is even thinking about those disconnected from God), what is your outreach temperature, and what's one practical step that you can do this month to raise it by one degree?
