2. What are disputable matters? Share some examples.
3. How does Paul ask us to respond to those who are 'weak' in faith in disputable matters? What reaction does Paul prohibit?
4. To whom is every believer accountable? How does remembering this help us to not judge others?
5. What are 4 things that God does better than us in his ministry of sanctification?
6. Summarize how we find and stay on the narrow path to not be licentious or legalistic? (Reference: the mountain illustration, *Celebration of Discipline*.)
7. What is the most important nugget to you personally after hearing the message?
