Isaiah 2:1-11; Matthew 24:42-51

- 1. What stood out to you the most in the message. Why?
- Discuss the message title: What is the difference between 'A' and 2. 'The' Great and Dreadful Day of the Lord?
- Read Isaiah 2:1-11. What is happening in the culture during the 3. time of Isaiah's prophecy and what is God saying (through the prophet) to the people of Israel/Judah?
 - Do you think the culture in Isaiah's time resembles our current times? Why or why not?
- **4.** Do you believe we are on the cusp of 'A' Great and Dreadful Day of the Lord? Why or Why not? (Note: Reference-Pastor Bryan shared many examples of 'A' Great and Dreadful Day of the Lord throughout the Bible and reminded us of his dream and previous message, "Jesus says, I AM coming VERY soon.")
- Read Matthew 24:42-51. (Jesus' words guiding us on how we are to respond to our current times)
 - Who do you think Jesus is speaking to in these passages and what is he saying? Who is the thief?
 - Describe the heart posture/attitude of a "wise and faithful servant." What would they be found doing at Jesus' return? What would an unwise, unfaithful servant be doing?
- Application: What do you feel God is personally speaking to you through the message and text? How will you apply it to your life (and the world you/we live in) right now?

WITNESS The Day of the Lord will be *great* for those who confess Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and dreadful for those who don't. Take time go around the room and share a name(s) of someone who does not know Jesus and in which you are carrying a burden for their salvation. Together as a group, pray for these individuals by name.
