WORD

Message Title: "Faith Tested" by Thanh Buswell

Scriptures: John 16:33; 1 Peter 4:12-13; Lamentations 3:21-23; Philippians: 6-7; Ephesians 6:10-18; Galatians 5:22-23, Mark 3:8, Hebrews 4:12, Romans 16:5; James 1:2-4; Philippians 3:10; Mark 11:22

1. What stood out to you the most in the testimony message?
2. *Read John 16:33, 1 Peter 4:12-13, and James 1:2-4.* As Christians, what type of mindset can we have when dealing with trials, based on the Word of God?
3. *Read Lamentations 3:21-23 and Romans 8:28.* "What do I know for sure?" What were the two attributes of God that Thanh placed her faith in during this trial? How can these attributes help to us to know that no matter what, we are okay (bulletproof!)?
4. *Read Philippians 4:6-7 and Ephesians 6:10-18.* What stood out to you as Thanh shared about the power and impact of prayer? How would you like to grow in your prayer life and what can you do to nurture this growth?
5. *Faith + Action = FRUIT.* (Or what we believe → governs our actions → determines what we experience.) What 3 types of fruit are produced by a faithful disciple? (Ref. Galatians 5:22-23, Mark 3:8, Romans 16:5.) Why does fruit matter? What fruit do you see in your life? What fruit do you desire more of, and what are you doing to tend to that growth?
6. "Have faith in God," Jesus says in Mark 11:22. What is God impressing upon you about your faith after Sunday's testimony message?

WITNESS

In John 13:35, Jesus says, "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." Resolve to love your brothers and sisters in Christ with intention this week through words/actions/deeds. This is evidence you are truly Jesus' disciple!
