03/26/17 - "Hated" - PBJ

WELCOME: Would you rather explore the depths of the ocean, or space?

WORD: READ John 15:18-27

What was your greatest takeaway from the scripture/message?

The word of God is meant to make ourselves relevant to Him, not make Him relevant to us. Talk about how that effects your view of His word? Have you been guilty of trying to make God's word relevant to you?

As we align ourselves to God's word we can expect power, results, and persecution. *How does the promise of persecution and rejection encourage you?*

When we know in advance that persecution is coming our way, we can be spiritually prepared. *How do your prepare for persecution and rejection?*

It's very important that in the midst of the promise we present the gospel as truth in love. What does your presentation of "kindness and mercy + repentance and righteousness" look like in your daily interaction with others?

Jesus says in verse 25 - "But this is to fulfill what is written in their Law: 'They hated me without reason." Why do you think the world would hate Jesus without any sort of reason?

When we're being persecuted and questioned; the power isn't in the debate, it's in the Spirit. *Have you encountered the Spirit's power and direction while being questioned about your faith?*

WITNESS: When we are completely aligned with Christ's commission to GO and reach others for the gospel we win, even in the midst of rejection. *What is your action plan to encounter a win this week for Christ?*
