## Worship: Read Psalm 47

## Word: Read Matthew 21:1-11

1. What is one thing about the sermon/Scriptures that really stuck out to you, and why?

2. What is something new you learned about Jesus' Triumphal entrance into Jerusalem?

3. What was the significance of Jesus riding in on a donkey? (HINT: Refer to Zechariah 9:9, also consider the difference between a war horse and a donkey.)

4. How did the crowd react to Jesus' entrance, and why do you think they responded that way (see verses 8-9)?

5. In Matthew 27, we see the same crowd calling for the crucifixion of Jesus. Why? How did they misinterpret Jesus' plan for salvation?

6. In what ways might we misunderstand/misinterpret salvation and the purposes of Jesus

7. We learned that "salvation often disrupts before it delivers." How has/is Jesus "disrupting" your plans or expectations? How do you think that "disruption" will lead to an abundance of life?

Witness: Take ten seconds to think of the name of the one person you will commit to inviting to church this Easter Sunday and pray for them.
