**Worship:** Listen to *The Cross is Enough* by Pursue Worship

**Word:** Read Luke 24:36-49.

- Why was it essential for Jesus to establish that he was not a ghost, that he had indeed risen spirit and body?
- In John's version of this scene (John 20:28-29), Thomas declared after seeing and touching Christ's body, "My Lord and My God!" To which Jesus responded "You believe because you see, more blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe." Explain how this is true?
- What parts of the Bible did the Apostles use to teach about Christ and the Cross? How did Jesus model this in Luke 24?
- PBJ used Matthew 28 to talk about what we do now that Jesus has risen. Read Matthew 28:16-20 and explain the significance of:
  - Authority (v. 18)
  - Discipline (v 19a)
  - Immersion (v. 19b)
  - Obedience (v. 20)
- How do these things allow us to experience the salvation we have already received?

Read Acts 1:4-9

- What do you think would have been the outcome if Jesus' followers had not waited on and then received the baptism of the Holy Spirit before venturing out on His mission?

**Witness:** Close with a prayer of surrender - asking Jesus to pour out the Holy Spirit upon your group.
