



Welcome: What happened last week that caused you (or should have caused you) to be grateful?

Worship: Pray and praise God for who He is and for His commitment and faithfulness to us.

Word: Read *John 21:15-25*

- What are a couple reasons that Jesus may have told Peter to take care of His sheep three times?
- What did Jesus mean when He instructed Peter (and us) to “feed” and “take care” of His sheep?
- How would Jesus’ prophecy of Peter’s death as a martyr actually embolden Peter?
- Can you relate to how Peter confused/compared his own personal and unique calling to John’s calling (*see verse 22*)? How can we avoid confusion/comparison in hearing and obeying our unique calling? Do you sense/know what your unique role is in executing the Great Commission (*Matthew 28:19-20*)?

Jesus makes it clear that it’s impossible to love Him if we aren’t actively seeking to love what He loves!

- Go around and share one believer and one non-believer who you are actively seeking to love and describe how.
- If you are not pouring into a believer and/or non-believer, share who you want to be intentionally loving, and one tangible way you will demonstrate that love. (See *James 2:14-26, 1 John 4:20*.)
- What was the most impactful thing about the Way of Salvation series for you, and how will it change the way you live?
