Welcome: What are you looking forward to most this summer?

- 1. What is one thing about the sermon/Scriptures that really stuck out to you, and why?
- 2. How can you relate to Ananias' initial response? When have you responded to God with "I gotta do what?", and why did you respond this way?
- 3. What are some major differences between our will and God's will, and why does discipleship require the total surrender of our will? Why would some people call this "reckless"?
- 4. In what area of your life is it difficult for you to say "I'm not in charge anymore." Why do you think it is so difficult?
- 5. Ananias trusted God with the outcome of his obedience. Do you think that was hard for him? Why, or why not?
- 6. Is it easier or harder for you to trust God with the outcome of your obedience? Can you give an example?
- 7. Be honest with yourself; as a disciple of Christ, what one step is God leading you to take in reckless obedience today?

Witness: How do you think your reckless obedience to God could lead to being an effective witness?
