5. Ananias trusted God with the outcome of his obedience. Do you think that was hard for him? Why, or why not?
6. Is it easier or harder for you to trust God with the outcome of your obedience? Can you give an example?
7. Be honest with yourself; as a disciple of Christ, what one step is God leading you to take in reckless obedience today?

Witness: How do you think your reckless obedience to God could lead to being an effective witness?
