WORD <u>1 Corinthians 11:17-34</u>

- 1. What stood out to you the most in the message? Why?
- Why do we exist in "a highly charged environment" when we gather as church in the name of Jesus? Describe what is happening in the spiritual realm.
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 11:17-22. How was the Corinthian church abusing the Lord's supper when they gathered, creating divisions/factions within the church? Apply this to today's church.
- 4. Read verses 23-26. What are words that describe a worthy posture and attitude to have as we receive the elements and what it represents? How would we receive it in an unworthy manner?
- 5. Read verses 27-29. This passage exalts the sacrament and sacredness of Communion. Consider anything we do in a sacred sense as the Body of Christ when we gather (worship/singing, prayer, teaching and receiving the Word, altar calls, dGroups, youth group, weddings etc.):
 - How can we be careful not to bring in an unworthy heart or mind into these sacred environments?
 - How might we 'drink' judgment upon ourselves if we fail to discern the sacredness of the gathering?
- 6. Read verse 30-31. Why were many weak and sick or fallen asleep because they did this with an unworthy manner? (In other words, what grace are we forfeiting?)
- **7.** What are the 3 critical items that one should consider before receiving the elements?
- **8.** After hearing this Word, what is God impressing upon your heart? What is your faithful response to it?

WITNESS Close by reading John 3:16. This week, continue to meditate on the Cross and the Communion we took together on Sunday. Pray that the Lord would keep our hearts/minds in a posture of love and extreme humility as we walk out in the world as ambassadors for Christ.
