



Welcome: What was the last song you listened to?

Worship: Read Psalm 118 as a group.

Word: *Read John 18:1-14*

- What did Pastor Bryan mean when he said Jesus “wasn’t arrested by the will of man, but the will of God”?
- In verse 6, why do you think the soldiers fell to the ground?
- What was the “cup” in verse 11? *See also Luke 22:39-46.*
- When Jesus drank the cup, what did He replace it with?
- In verse 10, Simon Peter wasn’t being brave but was reacting in fear. Describe a time recently where you reacted in fear/acted in the flesh? What were the consequences? In retrospect, what do you think Jesus would have wanted you to do?
- Pastor Bryan said that the first step of salvation is to receive the grace that Jesus died to give us. He explained that we cannot serve Him until we have been served by Him. However, some of us have received His grace but have grown too comfortable consuming, and are being called and empowered to give up comfort to join Him on His mission (giving up short-term comfort for long-term glory).
 - When you heard the sermon and read these verses, were you more prompted to stop performing and rest, or to wake up and join His mission?
 - Where are you in regards to grace? (Do you need it to come to you or to start working through you?)

Witness: Set a daily alarm on your phone to remind you to pray for one person whom you love who isn’t following Jesus.
