## WELCOME & WORSHIP Meet at the front of Sanctuary. WORD 1 Corinthians 14:1-25

1. What stood out to you the most in the message? Why?

## Read 1 Corinthians 14:1-25 and discuss the following questions.

- **2.** Why do you think we do not often see or experience a move of the Holy Spirit the way Paul describes in these Scriptures?
- **3.** What is prophecy and what is tongues? Why does Paul emphasize that one should earnestly desire spiritual gifts, especially prophecy over tongues?
- **4.** What are the 3 categories Pastor Bryan used to differentiate types of 'tongues'? Discuss these, sharing your understanding, experience, and your questions.
- 5. What is the purpose of spiritual gifts? And in what context should we strive to use our spiritual gifts? (Hint: 1 Cor. 13)

**Pray for One Another.** Take time to share prayer requests and pray for one another. Encourage your group to wait on God, allow time and space for him to speak through you as you pray for one another.
