## **DISCUSSION GUIDE**



Welcome: What are your favorite pizza toppings?

Worship: Listen to "Do it Again" by Elevation Worship.

Word: Read Joshua 6:1-20 Secondary Scripture References: James 1:2-4, Isaiah 55:8-9, Luke 9:23-24

- What part of the message/scripture spoke to you the most, and why?
- What do you think the Israelites thought when they heard God's command to march around Jericho for 7 days?
- What excuses have you made to not obey God's word?
- Obedience often requires patience. Have you experienced a season of waiting? What was that like, and how did you find peace?
- God's battle plan was different. In what ways does God call us to do things that may seem unconventional/unusual?
- As Jericho fell, we see that obedience to God leads us to extraordinary victory. So, although it leads to a place of waiting and vulnerability, why is obedience to God the safest place to be? How have you experienced abundant life and victory as a result of your obedience to Him?
- How is God calling you to obedience right now? Go around the circle and share how you will be obedient to God's word/calling this week.
