WORD *Message Title:* "Babylon: In It, Not Of It | "Orientation" (Part 2)

Scripture: Daniel 1

1. What part of the message or Scripture stood out to you most this week? Why?

Read Daniel 1:1-7 and discuss the following:

- **2.** What are the attributes of Daniel highlighted in the message? Why was this an asset to the King of Babylon?
- **3.** Which of these qualities impresses you the most? Which qualities would personally help you the most living in today's "Babylon"?

Read verse 8-15 and discuss the following:

- **4.** Why do you think Daniel drew the line when it came to eating the "royal food"? What was at stake for Daniel?
- **5.** What would be an equivalent core conviction you have between God's way and the "royal food" of the world today? What is at stake for you in that choice?
- 6. "Sometimes faith is buying God time." What did Pastor Bryan mean by this? How would you apply this to a situation in your past or present?

Read verses 16-21 and discuss the following:

7. How do we glorify God when we have prominence? What would give others a witness that God is the Lord of All in your life? What do you need to surrender in order for God to have it all?

Digging Deeper - Inductive Bible Study (IBS)
