3. According to PBJ's interpretation, who is the ruler (Prince) of Tyre? (vs. 2) What is his major vice (Pride or Vanity)?
4. Are you naturally more prideful or vain? When carried away by these vices, what is the effect on your relationships?
5. Pastor Bryan said that, "Love/God throws us down before being ultimately thrown down, Love/God humiliates before the ultimate humiliation". What does that mean?
6. How has God used crisis and failure to give you wisdom? Where would you be today if God had allowed you to prosper in prideful/vain pursuits without correction?

Read 1 Chronicles 29:11-12

7. How did God create and maintain humility in David, so that he never fully lost sight of what these verses illustrate?
8. How is this verse both a remedy for despair and pride/vanity?
9. What does it mean to be magnanimous?
10. What is your personal #1 take away from this week's message?
