



**Welcome:** Go around and share one high and one low this past week?

**Worship:** Listen to *Break Open This Box* by BREAD & WINE.

**Word:** Read *John 21:1-14*

- What stood out to you from the scripture/message this week?
- In *John 20:30-31*, John discusses the purpose of his book, which would seem like a good place to conclude. Why do you think John decided to end the book with chapter 21?
- Although the disciples saw, touched and spent time with Jesus after His resurrection, and then were commissioned by Him (see *John 20:21-3*), they went fishing instead. Why do you think that was? How can you relate?
- Do you believe that the closer you grow in your relationship with Jesus the more dependent you become on Him? How has that been true in your life?
- In verse 7, Peter demonstrates that he was more concerned with the source than the supply. What is one area in your life where you are more focused on the supply (e.g. finances, health, success, fame, relationships, etc.) rather than the source (God)? What is one step you can take to shift your focus from said need to Jesus?

**Witness:** Set a daily alarm on your phone to pray for the person on your right that they may experience His grace, love and kindness and that it overflows to others.

**THIS WEEK:** Read *1 Kings 18:16-19:9* and compare to this week's scriptures. Also, read *John 21:15-25* before the weekend!
