Welcome: What is your favorite memory from high school, and why?

Worship: Read Psalm 121:1-8

Word: Read 1 Kings 19:1-18

- 1. What is one thing about the sermon/Scriptures that really stuck out to you, and why?
- 2. Name a time where you were tempted to give up and say "I have had enough, Lord,". What led you to that place?
- 3. What is so important about rest and nourishment? How do we see God provide it for Elijah, and how does He provide it for us?
- 4. What was God teaching Elijah by revealing Himself in the form of a whisper? What does that tell you about God and the way He reveals Himself in your life?
- 5. How has God revealed Himself in the quiet places of your life? Why is that important, especially compared to the more visible, outward moves of God?
- 6. We see Elijah called and reestablished for God's purposes. (v.15-16) How does the work of Christ, and the power of His Holy Spirit, reestablish us for the purposes of God?
- 7. What is God specifically instructing you to do in this next season? How will you take one action step of faith in obedience this week?

Witness: Write down the name of one person that is disconnected from God and put in a place where you will remember to pray for them daily this week!
