Message Title: "Good News for When There Is No Way You Can Be Saved" (Pt.2), 5/10/26

Luke: Good News for Broken People | Pastor Bryan James

Scriptures: Luke 1:26-45

1. What stood out to you in the message this week? Why?
2. Have you ever been in a situation (self-inflicted or inflicted upon you) in which you thought, 'There is NO WAY I can be saved from this.'?
3. What does Pastor Bryan mean by experiencing Salvation as a spiritual reality (vs. just therapy)? As Christians, discuss the 'why' behind discipleship/spiritual disciplines; how is discipleship the way we can experience the Salvation we boast in?
4. **Read Luke 1:25-38.** How is Mary's faith in God's Word an example to you?
5. **Read also Romans 10:17.** What does this verse tell us about where faith comes from? How are you currently living by faith in the Word of God?
6. **Read Luke 1:29-45.** How does faith put us in the right posture to receive favor, blessing (i.e., G.R.A.C.E) from God?
7. In what area of your life do you need to believe, by faith, that nothing is impossible with God? What keeps you from believing this?
8. How can the group encourage and pray for you this week?

Think of an 'impossible' situation in which you thought, '*There is no way I can be saved from this,*' yet you experienced God's saving grace through faith. Take this testimony, pray and ask the Lord to lead you to sharing with someone this week.
