Word: *Psalm* 37; *Colossians* 3:22-25; *Jonah* 4:1-3,10-11

- 2. In answering the topic question, "If Jesus is coming tomorrow, what do I do today?" Pastor Bryan preached on three important areas of living our life through the teaching of the three Scriptures/passages above.
 - What were these three important areas? (Hint: see below.)
 - Which of the three Scriptures and areas resonated with you the most currently and why?
- 3. Read and discuss Psalm 37 and how it relates to attitude (how to endure).
 - Describe what Pastor Bryan shared about King David and his incredible recognition and right understanding about who God is.
 - How would our ability to see God through the lens and attitude that David did help us to live today?
- 4. Read and discuss Colossians 3:22-25 and how it relates to **excelling** (how to live, how to act).
 - How is God speaking to you through this Scripture in your current circumstances and environments?
- 5. Read and discuss Jonah 4:1-3,10-11. The insight gleaned from Jonah teaches us **how to speak, how to minister** and what our ministry in the world is. How did Pastor Bryan apply this story directly to our current situation in America and in our personal 'ministry'? Share and discuss.

Witness: Pastor Bryan said there are two key aspects to our witness: how we live and what we say—telling the truth in love. Reflect on your witness: If Jesus came tomorrow, how would he feel about what I did today? If Jesus comes today, what will he find me doing when he comes? Pray that God gives you wisdom and clarity for the coming days ahead and by the leading and power of His Spirit, enable you to be an effective witness for Christ.
