Word: Read Matthew 7:7-12

1. How did/does this message personally speak to you?

2. What exactly are we to ASK God for?

3. What did PBJ say was the greatest thing we can receive from God?

4. After salvation, in what form should we expect God to answer? Why, though seemingly intangible, are words preferable?

5. Why do you think the "Golden Rule" is seemingly thrown in at the end of this passage?

6. The old hymn says, "Oh what needless pains we bare, just because we didn't take it to God in prayer." What burden do you need to take to God in prayer right now? (Have everyone answer)

Witness: Let's test this passage: Close by having each person in the group prayed for around their request. Make the prayers short, direct (seek Matthew 6:7-8), literally no more than about 20 seconds each. ASK that God's response would first come in the form of words that the person making the request hears, believes, (obeys if necessary), and very soon receives. Write down each prayer and each week get a report of how God has spoken and/or moved on each person's behalf!
