## **WORD** <u>1 Corinthias 4:20-21; 1 Corinthians 5</u>

- 1. What stood out to you the most in the message? Why?
- **2.** For the critical time we exist in, what are the 3 things God is doing in the life of this Church and its members:
  - How is he preparing us to be his bride for his coming?
  - How is he preparing us be his missionaries (the priesthood of all believers) for the Great Harvest to come?
  - How is he preparing us to be the remnant church in the midst of the great apostacy?
- **3.** *"The Great Harvest will be our children and young people."* As a church, how can we look for (anticipate) God reaching our children? What is a faithful response to preparing for this harvest?
- 4. Read 1 Cor. 4:20-21. What is Paul saying here and what was his hope in writing to the Corinthians?
- 5. Read 1 Cor. 5:1-3. 'We often attack people who say things we need to hear." What is Paul saying about judgment in the name of Jesus? What is the right context in which we are to judge another?
- 6. Read v. 4-5. Why would God hand us, if/when we are in sin, over to Satan? How is this a demonstration of his goodness and grace? (What were some examples of God doing this in the Bible?)
- 7. Read v. 6-8. "In the name of grace, *repent*." Discuss how sin breeds more sin and destruction in the Body of Christ.
- 8. Read v. 9-13. Paul, in the authority of Christ, is not speaking to imperfect people within the Body struggling with sin, but those who are boasting in it and are unrepentant and influencing others. What is the wise, humble way we deal with sin in both situations?

<u>Application:</u> Right now, what did PBJ encourage us to do in response to the message?

**WITNESS** Consider the Great Harvest of our children and young people. Think of those in your spheres of culture (including church), pray for them and ask the Lord to use you in discipling and sharing the Gospel.
