Message Title: Babylon: In It, Not of It | "God Speaks Through

Dreams" (Part 3) by Pastor Bryan James, 11/9/2024

Scriptures: Daniel 2. See also Matthew 5:13-16; Joel 2:28-29.

1. What part of the message or Scripture uniquely spoke to you this week? Why?

- 2. Read Matt. 5:13-16. Discuss what it means to be "salt" and "light" in today's culture; compare how Daniel and the Israelites were called to the do the same in Babylon.
- **3.** Daniel was writtein in Aramaic and Hebrew; the Aramaic portion begins at 2:4 through 7:28. What was Daniel's (God's) purpose in using Aramaic?

Read Daniel 2:1-3 and discuss the following:

4. In the ancient world, the spiritual realm was always at the forefront. Has the modern era led to an unenglightend culture in which Christians may read the Word like a "recipe book," approach prayer like a liturgy, or despise the supernatural, mysterious things of God (e.g., prophecy, dreams, visions)? Have you seen evidence of this? What is your current personal experience?

Read verses 4-24 and discuss the following:

- **5.** How does God sovereignly use Nebuchadnezzar's dream as the crisis to create a platform for Daniel? What was important to God for the King of Babylon to understand through this crisis?
 - For the remnant church, do you think that our platform and greatest impact will come soon, in a time of crisis? Why or why not? What would that look like?
- **6.** Consider Daniel's example of faith and trust in God to speak personally & provide the supernatural wisdom and answers that would ultimately save him and his friends. How did Daniel respond to God's grace? Do you have a similar story? Share it!

"God Speaks Through Dreams" (Part 3) Sermon Series: Babylon: In It, Not of It

Application. Read Joel 2:28-29 and Galatians 3:3 Have you lost <u>full</u> faith in the supernatural and the mystery of what it is to be in a relationship with God—the intimacy, power and relevance—through the power of the Holy Spirit. What can you do this week to "fan the flame" of the Spirit in you and intimatley seek God?

DIGGING DEEPER - INDUCTIVE BIBLE STUDY (IBS)

For those studying *Daniel* using the IBS method, what additional insights did you gain through Observation, Interpretation, and Application (OIA) of the text? Share with the group:

- What insights did you gain about God, yourself and/or your circumcstances?
- How would God have you apply what you learned to your life today?

WITNESS Consider the choices you make throughout the week that would be a witness for God's ways vs. the world's. Ask the Lord to use you to be salt and light and for opportunity to share your 'why' and the hope you have.

Share prayer requests and pray for one another. Allow space to wait and listen for God to speak, as you pray.
