Read Romans 10:1-21

1. What stood out to you in the message and why?

Read verse Romans 10:1-5.

- 2. Why did the Israelite's zeal and 'superficial' righteousness (verse 5) in ordering their lives still not lead them to the right conclusion? What did they lack?
- Pastor Bryan compared this to the Word that doesn't take root and produce fruit in the life of a believer. How can zeal with lack of true knowledge lead us to be unfruitful in what we do (even seemingly good things)?

Read verses 6-17.

4. Which verse(s) makes the biggest impression on you personally about your Salvation and that of others? Why?

Read verse 18-21.

- 5. How did Paul address to the Jew that the inclusion of all the nations was always in the heart of God?
- (Verse 20-21) Awakening is not dependent on revival; God's passion will not be thwarted by the lack of passion of his people when they become obstinate. How can this fill us with greater faith to share our faith in a dark world?

- 7. What are the two applications that PBJ gave us?
- How is the Lord speaking to you personally through the message? What do you need to do in order to respond faithfully?
