Scriptures: James 1:2-8; Isaiah 3:1; Ezekial 14:12-23; 2 Corinthians 9:6-11

1. What part of Sunday's message uniquely spoke to you? Why?

- 2. Read James 1:2-8. In this week's Scriptures, Isaiah and Ezekiel spoke a prophetic word from the Sovereign Lord regarding the tribulation that would come upon Judah and Israel. According to James, what is God's purpose for his people in times of affliction/tribulation? What does James instruct us to do in difficult times? How does this perspective keep us safe/secure?
- **3.** Read Is. 3:1 and Ez.14:12-23. Isaiah's word was for Judah and Israel as a nation, while Ezekiel's word focused on individual responsibility. Looking at the examples of Noah, Job and Daniel, how does one become righteous? How do we take personal responsibility as followers of Jesus, specifically what does this look like in both our "conduct and actions"? (Ez. 14:22-23)
- **4.** "Just because you are physically in the midst of my people, does not mean that you are truly, spiritually connected to me," says the Lord, "and under my covering, protection and blessing. Let's quit dating and get married instead. You marry me by joining my family." This was the prophetic word shared by Pastor Bryan on Sunday for our local body. What is God impressing upon you through this word and Sunday's teaching?
- **5.** Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-11. What are the promises declared in this passage for those who are faithful to sow generously into the Kingdom of God through faithful discipleship, stewardship, and leadership?
- **6. Application.** Read the <u>Monterey Church Membership Covenant.</u> How is God calling you to personal action through this message?
