- 3) Is it peace, if it's not peaceful for all? What has happened to bring about this peace for all? (vs 4)
- 4) Explain the difference between stepping into conflict to punish/reward vs stepping into conflict with a motivation for all to flourish.
- 5) In what way is submission tied to peace? Explain how wisdom brings peace, and submission requires asking for wisdom, and always trusting the ways (wisdom) of God beyond our comprehension.
- 6) How does calling this Ruler both the shoot from the stump of Jesse, and the root of Jesse give away the identity of this Ruler?
