B. GROUP DISCUSSION

1. Please read the Parable found in Luke 20:9-19. What are the angles to this parable? Who is the land owner? The messengers? The tenants? What are some of the many points that Jesus could be stressing to His listeners?

2. The Great Virus (Original Sin) is believing that we are the "owners." Explain this sin from the perspective of the original lie in the Garden of Eden that the first humans believed, which their children assume.

3. In what ways do you assume ownership?

4. One of the symptoms of that Great Virus can be seen in how we "treat" messengers. How does science or naturalism treat messengers? How is it also abusive to simply explain them away? What are other ways we abuse or dismiss the messengers?

5. Pastor Don said that the inability to control life is actually proof that there is an owner, and that we are simply tenants. If someone tried to use the seeming randomness of evil as a way to prove that God does not exist, how could you use that same argument to make a case for the existence of God?

6. In order to defeat a virus, the virus is used to defeat itself. How does this work out in the Gospel. How did God use "hatred" to defeat itself?
