The Great Commission

16 Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. 17 And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted. 18 And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

1. Read **Matthew 28:16-20**. Do you remember anything about the sermon? What is still sticking with you, challenging or comforting to you?
2. How does Jesus' address to His original disciples resonate as relevant in your life today? Is it optional for disciples (Christians) today?
3. Do you feel comfortable thinking of yourself as a “disciple?”
 - If not, why not?
 - If so, do you feel that this passage is directed for you?
4. Can we actually “make disciples?” How much does God do? How much do we do?
5. **What’s your plan?**
 - How do you grow best, spiritually? *Reading? Writing? Listening? Talking?*
 - Are you already being discipled by someone else?
 - Who will you ask?
 - Are you discipling anyone?
 - Who will you ask?
 - If you already have a plan, how’s it working for you? Anything need to be added or eliminated?
