Sermon Notes

“But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.” John 4:23-24

Greek Key Words

proskynéō means “worship”
pneuma means “spirit”
alētheia means “truth”

True worship is not feigned, fictitious, or false. We don’t need to pretend we’re okay in God’s presence. We can be as broken and beat up as we need with Him. The key here is that we don’t forget to worship Him during these times. Because worship changes us.

When we limit ourselves in the ways that we worship Him, this only limits what He can do for and through us!

Daily practices for worship in our lives outside of Sunday morning:

Make intentional room for God.

Remember that worship is about God, *not* us.

Consider everything an act of worship.

Tradition does not have to play a role in our worship.

Key scriptures:

John 4:23-24
Luke 8:43-48
Romans 12:1
Psalm 55:22
Job 1:20-22
Mark 12:30-31

For Reflection: Be encouraged in how you can worship God in your own personal ways, and in your daily routine. When do you feel most in tune with God’s Spirit? Is your worship a genuine act of service to God, or is it rooted in an empty tradition? What does spirit and truth look like in your daily walk with Jesus? What is holding you back from truly worshipping Him?
