

## What is Chrysalis?

Chrysalis "Flights" (for 10th through 12th graders) are three-day events. This three-day spiritual renewal time allows you to learn more about faith, experience Christian love and support, and make new faith commitments. The point is to inspire, challenge and equip you for a closer friendship with Christ and for Christian action at home, church, school, and community.

Chrysalis lifts up a way to enjoy Christ's friendship and love and be Christ's friend and partner in the world. The three days focus on God's grace, your experience with Christ as a friend, what it means to be the body of Christ, and giving love to a needy world.

## Who should go to Chrysalis?

Chrysalis is open to members of any Christian denomination. Chrysalis is for the development of Christian leaders who:

1. **Have** the desire to strengthen their spiritual lives
2. **May** have unanswered questions about their faith

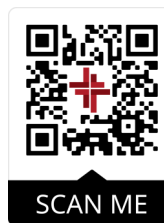
We are experiencing **28 Days of Prayer** for the month of **February**. May we seek His guidance and wisdom.
