1 John 5:20: And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding so that we may know him who is true; and we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.

Galatians 2: 20: And it is no longer I who live, but it is Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Distraction: something that turns your attention away from something you want to concentrate on.

When we **remember** what God has done – we are at a place to be aware of what God is doing in this very moment. We become aware of His presence all around us all of the time.

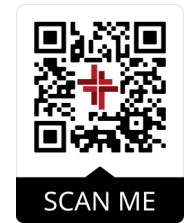
