SERMON NOTES

Giving Up Luke 5:1-11

Today we begin a Lenten series called, Giving Up. During this series will be exploring several things that Christ-followers need to give up as a part of their devotion to the Lord. Today we will learn something of the process and outcome of giving up in general.
