Sermon Notes

Living Like China In A Paper Plate World II Timothy 2:20-21

Today's message is taken from the image that Paul uses to challenge Timothy to be the valuable spiritual vessel God had made him to be. We are challenged to do the same. But this is not easy. For the world we live in not only upholds that which is of limited value, it also undermines our own sense of value. So as you listen today, resolve in your heart that you don't want to settle for a "paper plate" existence.

Questions For Reflection:

1. What struck you as you heard the comparison between living like fine china and living like a paper plate?
2. Which image seems to best characterize your life lately? Why is that?
3. What do you need to do in order to better live into the "fine china" life that God desires for you?
