2. What step do you need to take in response to what your body is telling you?
3. Are you having a substance abuse problem? Are you worried that might have a substance abuse problem? If so, who do you need to invite to help you face it? Will you do it today?
4. When has your pride gotten the best of you?
5. Why is it important to admit your own vulnerabilities?
6. How well are you keeping your soul?
