SERMON NOTES

Giving Up: Control
John 18:1-11

Today we return to the life of Peter as we explore the need to give up control. This will be a challenge to our tendency to seek our own will above God's.

1. Control is primarily a kingdom issue.
2. The problem comes when the Kingdom of God comes into conflict with the kingdom of self.
3. Each of us are called to give up our sword.

Questions For Reflection:

1. What or who do you seek to control most often?
2. What are some of the negative consequences you have experienced from the need to be in control?
3. What sword are you needing to give up?
