Church office closed on Monday, January 15 in observance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day

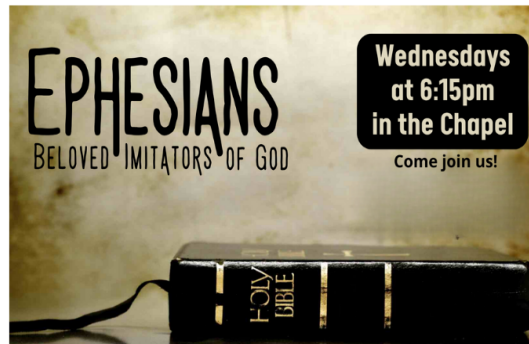

SERMON NOTES

The Jesus Life: What It Looks Like - Part 2

Today we continue exploring some of the traits we see in Jesus that mark not only the way He lived but also are to be emulated in our own lives.
