### *Selected highlights:*

- Adopted the new FLC welcome statement by unanimous consent
- Finalized an approach to long range planning
- Approved purchase of the new automated external defibrillator and a new sanitary pump – both recommended by the Facilities Committee.
- Increased flood insurance coverage as recommended by the Finance Committee
- Approved temporary Office Manager Assistant position for the period June 3 to August 26, 2026
- Authorized the new church directory project
