through October. Although the approved
2025 budget showed expenses exceeding
income of \$21,574 for the year, our goal is
to break even each year so we do not use
savings to fund our operations.


STEWARDS OF GOD'S LOVE DOWN, IN, AND OUT: LOVING GOD AND LOVING OUR NEIGHBOR

DISCIPLESHIP LOOKS OUTWARD

We look outward to see how God is calling us to love our neighbor with all that God has entrusted to our care. We are a church that believes Jesus is God's "Yes" to us. Our lives can be a "Yes" to others. Stewardship is one way that we can be that "Yes" to others. When asked: "What is the greatest commandment?" Jesus responds, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Matthew 22:37-39). We are called to love, not just with our words but with our whole lives. Stewardship is the way that we use all of our resources — Time, Talent, Treasure — to love God and our neighbor. Stewardship transforms God's commandment to "love our neighbors as ourselves" from a religious expression into a way of life.

During this stewardship season, you are asked to prayerfully reflect on your stewardship commitment in the following ways:

- First, consider increasing your giving to Faith Lutheran by 1%
- Second, consider using an electronic funds transfer program for your giving.
