Leviticus 18:6, 20-23 (ESV) <sup>6</sup>"None of you shall approach any one of his close relatives to uncover nakedness. I am the Lord......<sup>20</sup>And you shall not lie sexually with your neighbor's wife and so make yourself unclean with her. <sup>21</sup>You shall not give any of your children to offer them to Molech, and so profane the name of your God: I am the Lord. <sup>22</sup>You shall not lie with a male as with a woman; it is an abomination. <sup>23</sup>And you shall not lie with any animal and so make yourself unclean with it, neither shall any woman give herself to an animal to lie with it: it is perversion.

Life Principle: In His Goodness And Wisdom, The Lord Absolutely Forbids Some Widely Practiced And Accepted Sexual Activities.

Leviticus 18:5 (ESV) <sup>5</sup>You shall therefore keep my statutes and my rules; if a person does them, he shall <u>live by them</u>: I am the Lord.

1 Corinthians 6:9–11 (ESV) <sup>9</sup>Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality, <sup>10</sup>nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God. <sup>11</sup>And <u>such were some of you</u>. But you were <u>washed</u>, you were <u>sanctified</u>, you were <u>justified</u> in the <u>name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God</u>.

Proverbs 6:28–29 (ESV) <sup>28</sup>Or can one walk on hot coals and his feet not be scorched? <sup>29</sup>So is he who goes in to his neighbor's wife; none who touches her will go unpunished.

1 Corinthians 6:9 (ESV) <sup>9</sup>Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor <u>adulterers</u>, nor men who practice homosexuality,

Hebrews 13:4 (ESV) <sup>4</sup>Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for <u>God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous</u>.

Matthew 5:27–29 (ESV) <sup>27</sup>"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' <sup>28</sup>But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart. <sup>29</sup>If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body be thrown into hell.

Life Principle: In His Goodness And Wisdom, The Lord Absolutely Forbids Some Widely Practiced And Accepted Sexual Activities.

Leviticus 18:21 (ESV) <sup>21</sup>You shall not give any of your children to offer them to Molech, and so profane the name of your God: I am the Lord.

Matthew 15:19 (ESV) <sup>19</sup>For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, <u>adultery</u>, <u>sexual</u> <u>immorality</u>, theft, false witness, slander.

Colossians 3:5 (ESV) <sup>5</sup>Put to death therefore what is <u>earthly</u> in you: <u>sexual immorality</u>, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.

1 Thessalonians 4:3–5 (ESV) <sup>3</sup>For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you <u>abstain</u> <u>from sexual immorality</u>; <sup>4</sup>that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor, <sup>5</sup>not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who do not know God;

Leviticus 18:22 (ESV) <sup>22</sup>You shall not lie with a male as with a woman; it is an abomination.

Leviticus 18:23 (ESV) <sup>23</sup>And you shall not lie with any animal and so make yourself unclean with it, neither shall any woman give herself to an animal to lie with it: it is perversion.

Life Principle: In His Goodness And Wisdom, The Lord Absolutely Forbids Some Widely Practiced And Accepted Sexual Activities.

Leviticus 18:24–29 (ESV) <sup>24</sup>"Do not make yourselves unclean by any of these things, for by all these the nations <u>I am driving out before you</u> have become unclean, <sup>25</sup>and the land became unclean, so that <u>I punished its iniquity</u>, and <u>the land vomited out its inhabitants</u>. <sup>26</sup>But you shall keep my statutes and my rules and do none of these abominations, either the native or the stranger who sojourns among you <sup>27</sup>(for the people of the land, who were before you, did all of these abominations, so that the land became unclean), <sup>28</sup>lest the land vomit you <u>out when you make it unclean</u>, as it vomited out the nation that was before you. <sup>29</sup>For everyone who does any of these abominations, the persons who do them <u>shall be cut off from among their people</u>.
