Bible Recap Leviticus: Leviticus 19:1

Leviticus 19:1–2 (ESV) ¹And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, ²"Speak to all the congregation of the people of Israel and say to them, <u>You shall be holy</u>, for I the Lord your God am holy.

Hebrews 12:14 (ESV) ¹⁴Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord.

1 Peter 1:14–16 (ESV) ¹⁴As obedient children, <u>do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance</u>, ¹⁵but as <u>he who called you is holy</u>, you also be holy <u>in all your conduct</u>, ¹⁶since it is written, <u>"You shall be holy, for I am holy."</u>

Leviticus 19:3a (ESV) ³Every one of you shall revere his mother and his father.....

Life Principle #1: A Holy Person Will Honor And Care For Their Parents.

Matthew 15:3–4 (ESV) ³He answered them, "And why do you break the commandment of God for the sake of your tradition? ⁴For God commanded, 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'Whoever reviles father or mother must surely die.'

1 Timothy 5:8 (ESV) ⁸But if anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, <u>he</u> has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

Leviticus 19:3b–4 (ESV) ...you shall keep my Sabbaths: I am the Lord your God. ⁴Do not turn to idols or make for yourselves any gods of cast metal: I am the Lord your God.

Life Principle #2: A Holy Person Will Honor God As God.

Isaiah 58:13–14 (ESV) ¹³"If you turn back your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on my holy day, and <u>call the Sabbath a delight</u> and <u>the holy day of the Lord honorable</u>; if you honor it, not going your own ways, or seeking your own pleasure, or talking idly; ¹⁴then you shall take delight in the Lord, and I will make you ride on the heights of the earth; I will feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father, for the mouth of the Lord has spoken."

Malachi 1:13 (ESV) ¹³But you say, '<u>What a weariness this is</u>,' and you snort at it, says the Lord of hosts. You bring what has been taken by violence or is lame or sick, and this you bring as your offering! Shall I accept that from your hand? says the Lord.

Matthew 22:37–38 (ESV) ³⁷And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. ³⁸This is the great and first commandment.

Isaiah 45:22 (ESV) ²²"<u>Turn to me</u> and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For <u>I am God, and there is no other.</u>

Leviticus 19:9–10 (ESV) ⁹"When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not reap your field right up to its edge, neither shall you gather the gleanings after your harvest. ¹⁰And you shall not strip your vineyard bare, neither shall you gather the fallen grapes of your vineyard. You shall leave them for the poor and for the sojourner: I am the Lord your God.

Life Principle #3: A Holy Person Will Help Provide For The Needy.

James 1:27 (ESV) ²⁷Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to <u>visit orphans and widows in</u> <u>their affliction</u>, and to keep oneself unstained from the world.

1 John 3:17–18 (ESV) ¹⁷But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him? ¹⁸Little children, let us not love in word or talk but <u>in deed and in truth</u>. Leviticus 19:11–13a (ESV) ¹¹"You shall not steal; you shall not deal falsely; you shall not lie to one another. ¹²You shall not swear by my name falsely, and so profane the name of your God: I am the Lord. ¹³"You shall not oppress your neighbor or rob him......

Life Principle #4: A Holy Person Will Be Totally Honest All Of Their Interactions With Others.

Ephesians 4:25 (ESV) ²⁵Therefore, having <u>put away falsehood</u>, let each one of you <u>speak the truth</u> with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.

Matthew 5:37 (ESV) ³⁷Let what you say be simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything more than this comes from evil.

Leviticus 19:13b–14 (ESV) The wages of a hired worker shall not remain with you all night until the morning. ¹⁴You shall not curse the deaf or put a stumbling block before the blind, but you shall fear your God: I am the Lord.

Life Principle #5: A Holy Person Will Not Take Advantage Of Another Person's Situation.

James 5:4–6 (ESV) ⁴Behold, the wages of the laborers who mowed your fields, <u>which you kept back by fraud, are</u> <u>crying out against you</u>, and the cries of the harvesters have <u>reached the ears of the Lord of hosts</u>. ⁵You have lived on the earth in luxury and in self-indulgence. You have <u>fattened your hearts in a day of slaughter</u>. ⁶You have condemned and murdered the righteous person. He does not resist you.

Leviticus 19:33–34 (ESV) ³³"When a <u>stranger sojourns with you</u> in your land, <u>you shall not do him wrong</u>. ³⁴You shall treat the stranger who sojourns with you as the native among you, and <u>you shall love him as yourself</u>, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God.

Leviticus 19:19 (ESV) ¹⁹"You shall keep my statutes. You shall not let your cattle breed with a different kind. You shall not sow your field with two kinds of seed, nor shall you wear a garment of cloth made of two kinds of material.

Leviticus 19:26–28, 31 (ESV) ²⁶"You shall not eat any flesh with the blood in it. You shall not interpret omens or tell fortunes. ²⁷You shall not round off the hair on your temples or mar the edges of your beard. ²⁸You shall not make any cuts on your body for the dead or tattoo yourselves: I am the Lord ³¹"Do not turn to mediums or necromancers; do not seek them out, and so make yourselves unclean by them: I am the Lord your God.

Life Principle #6. A Holy Person Will Not Engage In Any Activity Or Practice That Is Associated With The Occult Or Pagan Worship.

Deuteronomy 18:9–15 (ESV) ⁹"When you come into the land that the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the <u>abominable practices of those nations</u>. ¹⁰There shall not be found among you anyone who burns his son or his daughter as an offering, anyone who <u>practices divination or tells fortunes or interprets omens, or a sorcerer</u>. ¹¹or a charmer or a <u>medium or a necromancer or one who inquires of the dead</u>, ¹²for whoever does these things is an abomination to the Lord. And because of these abominations the Lord your God is driving them out before you. ¹³You shall be blameless before the Lord your God, ¹⁴for these nations, which you are about to dispossess, <u>listen to fortune-tellers and to diviners</u>. But as for you, the Lord your God has not allowed you to do this. ¹⁵"The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers—<u>it is to him you shall listen</u>—

Leviticus 19:35–36 (ESV) ³⁵"You shall do no wrong in judgment, in measures of length or weight or quantity. ³⁶You shall have just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin: I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt.

Life Principle #7. A Holy Person Will Be Honest In All Their Business Dealings And Practices.
