Bible Recap Joshua: Joshua 1:1 December 03, 2023

Joshua 1:1–2, 7-9. (ESV) After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, <sup>2</sup> "Moses my servant is dead. Now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the people of Israel..... <sup>7</sup> Only be strong and very courageous, being careful to do according to all the law that Moses my servant commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go. <sup>8</sup> This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. <sup>9</sup> Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

1 Cor 10:11 (ESV) <sup>11</sup> Now these things happened to them as an example, but they were written down for our instruction,...

#### Life Principle: Trust And Obedience Are Essential To Experiencing Many Of God's Promise Blessings.

Hebrews 6:11–12 (ESV) <sup>11</sup> And we desire each one of you to show the same earnestness to have the full assurance of hope <u>until</u> the end, <sup>12</sup> so that you may not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

James 1:22 (ESV) <sup>22</sup>But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

Joshua 2:1–2, 8-13, 17-19 (ESV) And Joshua the son of Nun sent two men secretly from Shittim as spies, saying, "Go, view the land, especially Jericho." And they went and came into the house of a prostitute whose name was Rahab and lodged there. <sup>2</sup> And it was told to the king of Jericho, "Behold, men of Israel have come here tonight to search out the land."... <sup>8</sup> Before the men lay down, she came up to them on the roof <sup>9</sup> and said to the men, "I know that the Lord has given you the land, and that the fear of you has fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land melt away before you. <sup>10</sup> For we have heard how the Lord dried up the water of the Red Sea before you when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites who were beyond the Jordan, to Sihon and Og, whom you devoted to destruction. <sup>11</sup> And as soon as we heard it, our hearts melted, and there was no spirit left in any man because of you, for the Lord your God, he is God in the heavens above and on the earth beneath. <sup>12</sup> Now then, please swear to me by the Lord that, as I have dealt kindly with you, you also will deal kindly with my father's house, and give me a sure sign <sup>13</sup> that you will save alive my father and mother, my brothers and sisters, and all who belong to them, and deliver our lives from death."..... <sup>17</sup> The men said to her, "We will be guiltless with respect to this oath of yours that you have made us swear. <sup>18</sup> Behold, when we come into the land, you shall tie this scarlet cord in the window through which you let us down, and you shall gather into your house your father and mother, your brothers, and all your father's household. <sup>19</sup> Then if anyone goes out of the doors of your house into the street, his blood shall be on his own head, and we shall be guiltless. But if a hand is laid on anyone who is with you in the house, his blood shall be on our head.

# Life Principle: Guilty People Who Deserve Divine Judgment Can Experience Salvation By Acting In Faith On God's Revelation.

James 2:25–26 And in the same way was not also Rahab the prostitute justified (vindicated) by works when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way? <sup>26</sup> For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also <u>faith apart from works is</u> dead.

Hebrews 11:31 (ESV) <sup>31</sup> By faith Rahab the prostitute did not perish with those who were disobedient, because she had given a friendly welcome to the spies.

Joshua 3:2–3 (ESV) <sup>2</sup> At the end of three days the officers went through the camp <sup>3</sup> and commanded the people, "As soon as you see the <u>ark of the covenant of the Lord</u> your God being carried by the Levitical priests, then you shall set out from your place and <u>follow it</u>..... <sup>9</sup> And Joshua said to the people of Israel, "Come here and listen to the words of the Lord your God." <sup>10</sup> And Joshua said, "Here is how <u>you shall know</u> that <u>the living God</u> is among you and that he will <u>without fail</u> drive out from before you the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Hivites, the Perizzites, the Girgashites, the Amorites, and the Jebusites. <sup>11</sup> Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth is passing over before you into the Jordan. <sup>12</sup> Now therefore take twelve men from the tribes of Israel, from each tribe a man. <sup>13</sup> And when the soles of the feet of the priests bearing the ark of the Lord, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of the Jordan, <u>the waters of the Jordan shall be cut off from flowing</u>, and the waters coming down from above shall stand in one heap.".... <sup>17</sup> Now the priests bearing the ark of the covenant of the Lord stood firmly on dry ground in the midst of the Jordan, and all Israel was passing over on dry ground until all the nation finished passing over the Jordan.

Joshua 4:5–7 (ESV) <sup>5</sup> And Joshua said to them, "Pass on before the ark of the Lord your God into the midst of the Jordan, and take up each of you a stone upon his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the people of Israel, <sup>6</sup> that this may be a sign among you. When your children ask in time to come, 'What do those stones mean to you?' <sup>7</sup> then you shall tell them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord. When it passed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. So these stones shall be to the people of Israel a memorial forever."

## Life Principle: God Gives Us Reminders Or Memorials Of His Past Victories Over Evil For Our Present Benefit.

Joshua 5:13–15 (ESV) <sup>13</sup> When Joshua was by Jericho, he lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, a man was standing before him with his drawn sword in his hand. And Joshua went to him and said to him, "Are you for us, or for our adversaries?" <sup>14</sup> And he said, "No; but I am the commander of the army of the Lord. Now I have come." And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped and said to him, "What does my lord say to his servant?" <sup>15</sup> And the commander of the Lord's army said to Joshua, "Take off your sandals from your feet, for the place where you are standing is holy." And Joshua did so.

## Life Principle: God's People Should Be Aiming To Accomplish God's Purpose According To God's Plans.

Joshua 6:1–5, 16-18, 24-25 (ESV) Now Jericho was shut up inside and outside because of the people of Israel. None went out, and none came in. <sup>2</sup> And the Lord said to Joshua, "See, I have given Jericho into your hand, with its king and mighty men of valor. <sup>3</sup> You shall march around the city, all the men of war going around the city once. Thus shall you do for six days. <sup>4</sup> Seven priests shall bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark. On the seventh day you shall march around the city seven times, and the priests shall blow the trumpets. <sup>5</sup> And when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, when you hear the sound of the trumpet, then all the people shall shout with a great shout, and the wall of the city will fall down flat, and the people shall go up, everyone straight before him.".... <sup>16</sup> And at the seventh time, when the priests had blown the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, "Shout, for the Lord has given you the city. <sup>17</sup> And the city and all that is within it shall be devoted to the Lord for destruction. Only Rahab the prostitute and all who are with her in her house shall live, because she hid the messengers whom we sent. <sup>18</sup> But you, keep yourselves from the things devoted to destruction, lest when you have devoted them you take any of the devoted things and make the camp of Israel a thing for destruction and bring trouble upon it..... <sup>24</sup> And they burned the city with fire, and everything in it. Only the silver and gold, and the vessels of bronze and of iron, they put into the treasury of the house of the Lord. <sup>25</sup> But Rahab the prostitute and her father's household and all who belonged to her, Joshua saved alive. And she has lived in Israel to this day, because she hid the messengers whom Joshua sent to spy out Jericho.

## Life Principle: God Graciously Gives Repeated Warnings About Upcoming Judgment So People Can Repent And Be Saved.

Gen 15:16. they shall come back here in the fourth generation (450 years), for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet complete."

2 Peter 3:9-10 (ESV) <sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise (of judgment) as some count slowness, but is <u>patient</u> toward you, <u>not wishing that any should perish</u>, but that all should reach repentance. But the day of the Lord (judgment) will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed (judged.)

Leviticus 18:24-25 (NLT) "Do not <u>defile</u> yourselves in any of these ways, for the people I am driving out before you <u>have defiled</u> themselves in all these ways.<sup>25</sup> Because the entire land has become defiled, <u>I am punishing the people who live there</u>. I will cause the land to vomit them out.

Deuteronomy 12:29-31 (NLT.) <sup>29</sup> "When the Lord your God goes ahead of you and destroys the nations and you drive them out and live in their land, <sup>30</sup> do not fall into the trap of following their customs and worshiping their gods. Do not inquire about their gods, saying, 'How do these nations worship their gods? I want to follow their example.' <sup>31</sup> You must not worship the Lord your God the way the other nations worship their gods, for they perform for their gods every detestable act that the Lord hates. They even burn their sons and daughters as sacrifices to their gods.

Revelation 9:20–21 (ESV) <sup>20</sup>The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, <u>did not repent</u> of the works of their hands nor give up worshiping demons and idols of gold and silver and bronze and stone and wood, which cannot see or hear or walk, <sup>21</sup> nor <u>did they repent</u> of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.

Jeremiah 18:7-8. <sup>7</sup> If at any time I declare concerning a nation or a kingdom, that I will pluck up and break down and destroy it, <sup>8</sup> and if that nation, concerning which I have spoken, turns from its evil, I will relent of the disaster that I intended to do to it.
