"and from Jesus Christ the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of kings on earth."

- Jesus is a faithful witness to us.
- Jesus was the firstborn of the dead for us.

Psalm 89:27 (ESV)

"I will make him the firstborn, the highest of the kings of the earth."

Revelation 1:17-18 (ESV)

"Fear not, I am the first and the last, and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades"

Revelation 1:5 (ESV)
