Chapter 9: **It's been the same from the beginning.**

Romans 9:6 (NIV)

“It is not as though God's word had failed. For not all who are descended from Israel are Israel.”

Romans 9:8 (NIV)

“it is not the children by physical descent who are God's children, but it is the children of the promise who are regarded as Abraham's offspring.

Galatians 3:16 (NIV)

“The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. Scripture does not say ‘and to seeds,’ meaning many people, but ‘and to your seed,’ meaning one person, who is Christ.”

Romans 9:17-18 (NIV)

“For Scripture says to Pharaoh, ‘For this very purpose I have raised you up, that I might show my power in you, and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth. So then he has mercy on whomever he wills, and he hardens whomever he wills.’”

Chapter 10: God's plan has succeeded.

Romans 10:4 (ESV)

Galatians 4:4-5 (NASB)

Romans 11:9-10 (ESV)

“Let their table become a snare and a trap,
a stumbling block and a retribution for them;
let their eyes be darkened so that they cannot see,
and bend their backs forever.”

Romans 11:11 (ESV)

So I ask, did they stumble in order that they might fall? By no means! Rather, through their trespass salvation has come to the Gentiles, so as to make Israel jealous.”

Romans 11:13 (ESV)

“I magnify my ministry in order to make my fellow Jews jealous and thus save some of them.”

Romans 11:25 (ESV)

“a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. And in this way all Israel will be saved”
